What is Spinal Decompression?

Spinal Decompression is defined as: Vertebral Unloading due to distraction and spinal positioning.

Does your treatment hurt?

Spinal Decompression is so gentle and relaxing to the spine that some patients fall asleep during treatment.

Do I need to put on a gown?

NO, You keep your clothes on.

What is the length of time for a treatment?

Treatment time is from 20-30 Minutes.

Can I bring a guest with me during treatment?

Yes, you are encouraged to bring a guest with you.

Why is treatment so effective?

The specific level of the spine that requires decompression is targeted. The computerized program ramps up and down the amount of axial distraction eliminating muscle guarding and permits decompression.

Who may benefit from Spinal Decompression?

Patients with LOW BACK PAIN and leg pain, neck & arm pain caused by degenerated and damaged spinal discs including bulging and herniated discs, severe spinal arthritis, spondylosis, stenosis, facet joint syndrome some cases of failed surgery. If other kinds of treatments have failed, you may be a good candidate for spinal decompression.

How does Spinal Decompression Work?

It is believed that the biomechanics work by targeting distraction at a specific disc level, creating negative pressure inside the disc that reduces the bulge

How can I be sure that Spinal Decompression will work for me?

Any individual cannot be sure that treatment will work. If you have a condition listed above there is a good probability that you will benefit from decompression. If you want to avoid injections, dangerous drugs and surgery, isn't decompression worth trying?

Can there be more than one problem causing my pain?

Yes, if you have been treated for only one problem with little or no relief, you may have several causes of your pain and suffering. At our office we check for several possible causes.

What can I expect if I just keep taking pain pills and hope the pain goes away? The same results!
